IODM 3Q Quarterly Activities Report and Appendix 4C

Key highlights

- Achieved quarterly cash receipts of A\$232k

IODM Limited (ASX:IOD, "IODM" or "the Company"), a cloud-based software solution that revolutionises business cash flow management is pleased to release its Quarterly Activities Report and Appendix 4C Quarterly Cash Flow Report for the period ended 31 March 2022 ("3Q FY22").

During the quarter, IODM received cash receipts from clients of A\$232k, this figure was an increase of 3.5% on the 3QFY21 and an increase of 24% on the previous quarter.

In addition to the universities that went live during the quarter, the company now has nine universities in its onboarding pipeline at various stages, with a view that they will all be live before the next major billing cycle for UK universities in September 22.

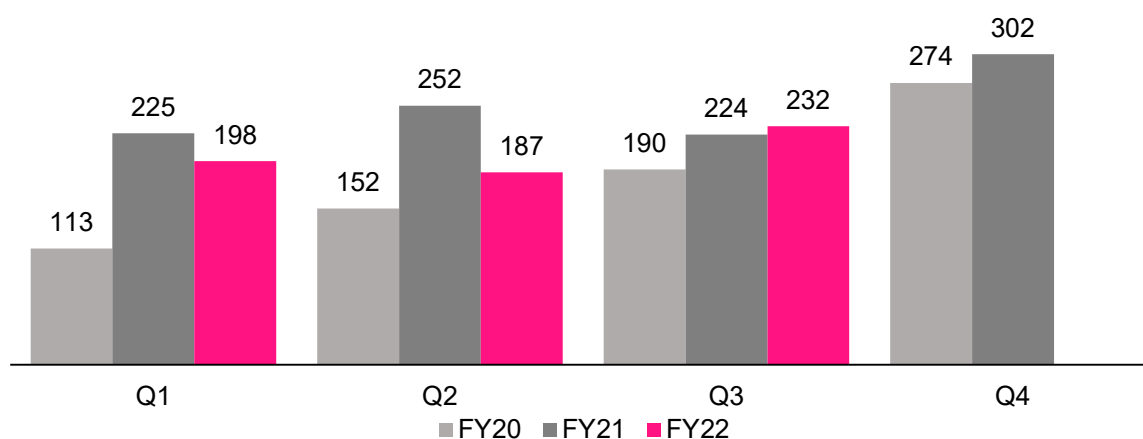
The company has held initial meetings with North American Universities with a few to finalising and implementing two during the June 22 quarter.

Corporate and Additional Information

In March 22 the Company spent \$5K on employing an additional employee in the UK to assist with sales and onboarding the UK educational institutions. This expenditure is included in the staff, administration, and corporate costs for the quarter.

Payments to related parties of the entity and their associates during the March 22 quarter totalled \$11K, which were all directors' fees.
