NOTICE PURSUANT TO SECTION 708A(5)(e) OF THE CORPORATIONS ACT 2001

As announced by Blina Minerals NL (**Company**) on 24 September 2019, the Company has acquired a 50% stake in Colour Minerals Pty Ltd pursuant to the heads of agreement entered into with Kalgoorlie Mine Management Pty Ltd (**KMM**) (the **Acquisition**).

On 25 September 2019 the Company issued 861,000,000 fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of the Company (**Shares**) to KMM in consideration for the Acquisition, as detailed in the attached Appendix 3B.
