TRADING HALT REQUEST – ASX Code: ALX

Atlas Arteria (“**ALX**”) requests a trading halt in respect of its stapled securities (ASX Code: ALX) pursuant to Listing Rule 17.1 with immediate effect.

For the purposes of Listing Rule 17.1, ALX advises that:

- 1 The trading halt is necessary as ALX expects to make an announcement to the ASX in connection with a proposed capital raising by way of a placement and share purchase plan offer (the “**Offer**”).
- 2 ALX requests that the trading halt continue until the earlier of ALX releasing an announcement in relation to the completion of the placement component of the Offer, or until the open of trading on Friday, 29 May 2020.
- 3 ALX expects that the trading halt will be ended by it making an announcement to the ASX in relation to completion of the placement component of the Offer.
- 4 ALX is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, or of any other information available at this stage that is relevant to the trading halt.
